Unattended Dogs

AKC Policy — Unattended Dogs in Vehicles (adopted at the July 2026 Board meeting):

“Dogs shall not be left unattended in a vehicle that is fully enclosed or without sufficient ventilation or airflow from the outside environment. A vehicle containing unattended dogs must provide continuous ventilation and conditions reasonably sufficient to protect the dogs from heat-related injury, illness, distress, or death. The presence of fans, air-circulation devices, climate-control systems, temperature-monitoring systems, remote alerts, or other electronic monitoring technology shall not, by itself, establish that a vehicle provides adequate ventilation or a safe environment for unattended dogs.

Leaving dogs unattended in a vehicle that is fully enclosed or without sufficient ventilation is recognized to be conduct prejudicial to the best interest of purebred dogs, the sport of purebred dogs and the American Kennel Club. Accordingly, individuals who engage in conduct which constitutes a violation of this policy may be subject to discipline pursuant to AKC’s Charter and Bylaws.”

In the grooming area — a recommendation from the show-giving clubs:

The clubs recommend that no dog be left unattended on a grooming table. A dog can slip from the edge and be caught by the grooming arm in moments. If you need to step away, please crate your dog first.

Notice to Exhibitors

Opening Date for Entries: Wednesday, October 14, 2026, 12:00 p.m. Central Time. No entries will be accepted before this date. **Closing Date for Entries:** Wednesday, January 6, 2027, 12:00 p.m. Central Time, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted. **Entry Fee:** \$38.00 for First Entry (includes \$.50 AKC recording fee & \$5.50 event service fee), \$35.00 for Additional Entry, \$35.00 Puppy / Bred by Exhibitor / Veteran. All entries must be accompanied by an email address for entry confirmation. Telephone, telegraph and unsigned entries CANNOT be accepted.

General Information

Entry fee shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred. Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in US funds. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms, and photocopies of the entry without the Agreement and Rules from the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form, are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Errors on Entry Blanks: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

A recording fee of 50 cents and an event service fee of \$5.50 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club Show. This fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the fee is collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2).

All dogs must be held on leash except when in the exercise area or crated. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. No entry shall be made or accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. The show-giving clubs, the show secretary, their agents and employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

Site Requirements

Tarps must be used under the grooming tables when using chalk — NO exceptions. Blowers allowed. Please respect the grounds and clean up after your dog. NO exercise pens in the outdoor covered area. Free parking is available on site. The show site will be available starting Friday at 12:00 p.m. Central Time. Judging schedule and map to the show site will be emailed / mailed as soon as possible after the closing of entries.

From the South (I-35): While driving northbound on I-35, take exit 256 RM 1431 toward Cedar Park (by IKEA). Turn right onto University Blvd. Continue straight for 16 miles, then turn right onto Bill Pickett Trail (last right before Highway 95). Take the second entry into the Expo Center, passing by the building. Entrance is on the far side, through glass doors.

From the South (Toll 130): While driving northbound on Highway 130, take exit 419 Chandler Rd / University Blvd. Turn right onto Chandler Rd. Continue straight for 11 miles, then turn right onto Bill Pickett Trail (last right before Highway 95). Take the second entry into the Expo Center, passing by the building. Entrance is on the far side, through glass doors.

New World Screwworm — Travel Requirements

Exhibitors are responsible for meeting the animal-health requirements of every state they travel through and return to.

Entering Texas: dogs 12 weeks and older need a current rabies vaccination and certificate. Texas does not require a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection for dogs entering from another state.

Returning home: most states now have New World Screwworm requirements for dogs arriving from Texas. These commonly include a CVI issued within 5 to 7 days of travel, a statement that the dog was inspected and found free of infestation, treatment of any open wound, and an entry permit requested in advance. Requirements differ by state and change frequently.

If your state requires a CVI, note that it must be issued **in Texas, within days of your departure** — arrange a veterinary appointment well before you travel, as local practices are busy on show weekends. Check with your own state veterinarian and at screwworm.gov before you leave home. The show site in Taylor is not within a designated infested zone as of this printing; zone boundaries change, so verify close to the show date.

AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class geared toward children 5–9 years of age. Children younger than five cannot participate. The safety of the children is a primary concern. Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time.

This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult. Although the word "judge" will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience — no junior will be "judged," but rather mentored with age-appropriate information to help prepare them for AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age. Each child will receive a participation ribbon or rosette to commemorate the experience.

Requirements

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter.
- Bitches in season are not permitted. A pre-entered dog may be substituted.
- A proper lead and collar are required.
- A responsible adult must accompany the child inside and outside the ring.
- Collies will be provided for any child who does not have one.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
